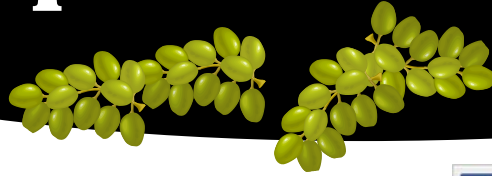

CALL FOR NOMINATIONS

Subdivision & Development Appeal Board



Smoky Lake County

Smoky Lake County Subdivision and Development Appeal Board is seeking public members for the purposes of ruling on Appeals to planning Decisions made within Smoky Lake County.

- Council will appoint a minimum of four (4) to a maximum of seven (7) Members at Large to serve on the Board when required.
- Remuneration will be provided to all public members of the Board as per County policy.

All nominations will be presented to Council.

ROLE OF THE BOARD:

Board members are required to make findings of fact based on evidence presented and then make a decision after conducting a hearing fairly and in accordance with legislation, administrative law and the principles of natural justice.

MEMBER REQUIREMENTS:

- Must not be an employee of the County, or a member of the Development Authority or Subdivision Authority for Smoky Lake County.
- Required to take training provided at the County's cost.
- Appeal Hearings and meetings normally scheduled during business hours.

Each appointment is for a term of one year, and is subject to re-appointment at Council's discretion.

SELF-NOMINATION SUBMISSIONS SHOULD INCLUDE:

- Statement about commitment to making fair Appeal Decisions in Smoky Lake County; and
- Talents and skills that would be brought to the Board.
