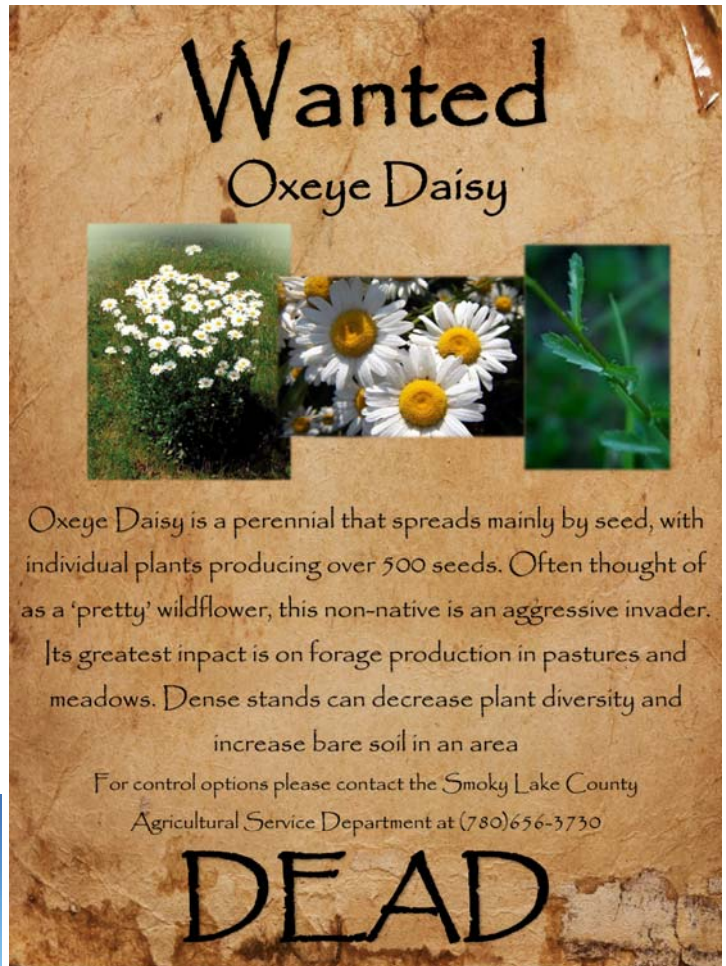


Alberta-Ukraine Genealogical Project

The Centenary Pioneer Recognition Program has been in operation since 2003, and is now nearing its completion. Only one year remains for people to nomination their ancestors to be included on the monument. The final unveiling of plaques will occur in 2018. Nominators are not required to be current residents of the original homestead to participate. Those nominated must have been residents of East Central Alberta, Ukrainian and non-Ukrainian alike, prior to 1915.

Oxeye Daisy is a perennial that spreads mainly by seed, with individual plants producing over 500 seeds. Often thought of as a 'pretty' wildflower, this non-native is an aggressive invader. Its greatest impact is on forage production in pastures and meadows. Dense stands can decrease plant diversity and increase bare soil in an area

2017-2019 GRAVEL CRUSHING TO STOCKPILE

Smoky Lake County invites tenders for the 2017 crushing of 100,000 Tonnes of Gravel Products to stockpile within the White Earth Creek Gravel Pit located at NW ¼ of Section 2-61-18-W4. 2018 and 2019 gravel volumes shall not be less than 85,000 Tonnes per year.

2017 Quantities required:

- Designation 4, Class 20 (3/4") material - 40,000 Tonne
- Designation 4, Class 25 (1") material - 47,000 Tonne
- Designation 4, Class 40 (1 ½") material - 13,000 Tonne

All bids are to be submitted on tender form provided in and in accordance with the "Tender Package". Tender Packages available at the Smoky Lake County Office during regular business hours or on the Alberta Purchasing Connection at <http://www.purchasingconnection.ca>.
