<b>1.</b>	<p><b>MEMBERSHIP:</b></p> <p>Two (2) members (Serving throughout their term) and one alternate.</p>
<b>2.</b>	<p><b>MANDATE:</b></p> <p>2.1 To assist the four municipalities (Smoky Lake County, Town of Smoky Lake, Village of Waskatenau and Village of Vilna) within the Smoky Lake Region, and the fire department(s) with evaluating current realities to ensure that all necessary legislative, reporting, operational and training elements exist to enable the fire department(s) to deliver all assigned services effectively and efficiently.</p> <p>2.2 To provide policy leadership and coordination on operations and future directions for the Smoky Lake Region's Fire and Rescue Service.</p> <p>2.3 Committee's key roles and responsibilities are to discuss and review issues, make recommendations and report these recommendations on relevant fire and rescue protective services issues to municipal Council(s) for their consideration and approval.</p> <p>2.4 To review, assist, monitor and advise on the implementation and development of Council's Policies, Standards and Procedures on all matters regarding the delivery of fire prevention, preparedness, response and recovery.</p>
