Legislation Reference:	Municipal Government Act, Section 11
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Purpose:	To establish a method to submit projects to private contractors in a tendering process and at the same time recognize local private contractors in the same process.
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Policy Statement and Guidelines:
<p>Through the budget, planning and actions of both Council and Administration, every effort will be made to always consider can “this job be privatized”. Questions to be asked:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Can the job in question be readily identified? 2. Can the job be privatized without impact on an associated government function, thereby causing inefficiency? 3. Can specifications or job requirements be drafted to allow a consistent and fair tendering process? 4. Can the job, upon awarding to a private contractor, be monitored and evaluated? <p>Should the answer to all the above questions be in the affirmative, the County will implement either a proposal request or tendering submission process.</p> <p><u>Proposal Request</u> To be used when one project or job may not have a clear start or end period and may have to be amended in operation.</p> <p><u>Tender Submission</u> To be used when a project or job may be specific in nature and time.</p> <p>Whether the proposal request or tender submission is implemented, cost saving to the County will be the primary objective, with emphasis on engaging local private contractors.</p>
