REGIONAL PHYSICIAN RECRUITMENT AND RETENTION COMMITTEE TERMS OF REFERENCE

- Membership:** Mayors/Reeves or designates from the following (Voting) municipalities:
- Smoky Lake County
 - Town of Smoky Lake
 - Village of Waskatenau
 - Village of Vilna
 - Thorhild County
- Administration:** Town of Smoky Lake.
(Non-Voting)
- Resources:** Physicians
(Non-Voting) Lakeland Community Health Advisory Council
Smoky Lake Foundation: Chairperson
Other Resources, as needed.
- Executive:** Chairperson and Vice-Chairperson to be appointed by the membership on an annual basis.
- Meetings:** At the Call of the Chairperson.
- Mandate:** To act as a Steering Committee to develop a process to recruit and retain physicians to the Smoky Lake / Thorhild area.
- To advocate the Provincial Government and Regional Health Authority to take more responsibility for the recruitment and retention of physicians in small rural areas.
