<b>Legislation Reference:</b>	Alberta Provincial Statutes
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<b>Purpose:</b>	To identify how emergency expenditures not in the budget are authorized for payment.
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<b>Policy Statement and Guidelines:</b>
<p>Payment of expenditures not included in a Total Function Budget or otherwise authorized by Council, the following procedures will apply:</p> <p><b><u>Definition: Emergency:</u></b></p> <p><b>Emergency:</b> An occurrence or situation that arises which could jeopardize the safety, health, welfare, or the protection of people and property in Smoky Lake County.</p> <p><b><u>For an Emergency:</u></b></p> <p>If in the opinion of the Reeve, Deputy Reeve, Chief Administrative Officer, a designated officer or an employee, an emergency arises – these persons shall be authorized to approve the said expenditure(s). A designated officer or an employee may authorize the expenditures only if they have been delegated that responsibility or it is contained with their respective job description.</p>
