Policy Statement and Guidelines:
<p>The Agricultural Service Board Committee will undertake a <b>Coyote Control</b> Program within it's boundaries under provisions of the <i>Agricultural Pest Act</i>.</p> <p>Upon receipt of a request for Coyote Control materials, the Agricultural Fieldman will thoroughly investigate reasons for the request. If, in the opinion of the Agricultural Fieldman, the request is justified, he may issue a limited number of control materials in accordance with guidelines as outlined by the Pest Control Branch, Alberta Agriculture.</p> <p>Smoky Lake County Agricultural Service Board will not issue Form 9's – Permit to Destroy Coyotes Using Dogs.</p> <p>At the discretion of the Agricultural Fieldman, landowners will be informed of alternative measures i.e. hunters and trappers. The County will provide a list of hunters and trappers available to assist landowners in dealing with problem coyotes.</p>
