



## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

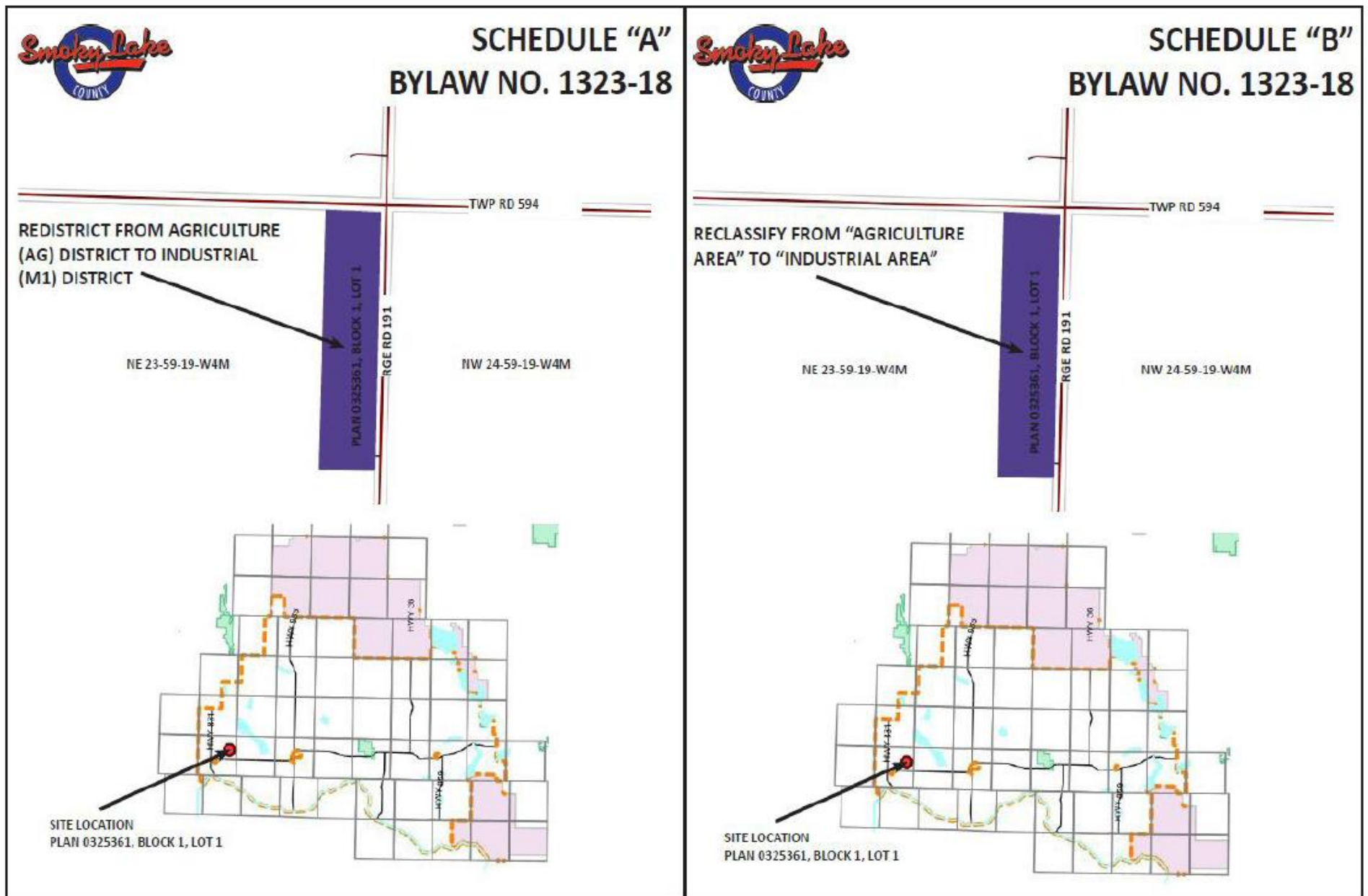
Take notice that pursuant to the Section 692 and Section 606 of the *Municipal Government Act*, the Council of Smoky Lake County is proposing to pass a bylaw (**Bylaw 1323-18**) to amend Smoky Lake County Land Use Bylaw 1272-14, to rezone the lands legally described as Plan 0325361, Block 1, Lot 1, from "**Agriculture (AG) District**" to "**Industrial (M1) District**", & to amend Smoky Lake County Municipal Development Plan Bylaw 1249-12, to reclassify the lands legally described as Plan 0325361, Block 1, Lot 1, from "**Agriculture Area**" to "**Industrial Area**".

The Public Hearing to obtain public input on proposed Bylaw No. 1323-18 will be held at the location and on the date and time as follows:

**Date:** December 6, 2018  
**Time:** 9:15 a.m.  
**Place:** Smoky Lake County Council Chambers  
4612 McDougall Drive in the Town of Smoky Lake

The purpose of Public Hearing is to obtain public input on proposed **Bylaw No. 1323-18**, which reads as follows:

1. That Appendix "B" of Smoky Lake County Bylaw No. 1272-14: Land Use Bylaw, be amended such that all portions of the lands legally described as Plan 0325361, Block 1, Lot 1, containing +/- 3.66 Ha (9.04 acres) in size more or less, as shown on Schedule "A", be rezoned from Agriculture (AG) District to Industrial (M1) District;
2. That Section 7.2 "Future Land Use Map" of Smoky Lake County Bylaw 1249-12: Municipal Development Plan, be amended such that all portions of the lands legally described as Plan 0325361, Block 1, Lot 1, containing +/- 3.66 Ha (9.04 acres) in size more or less, as shown on Schedule "B", be reclassified from Agriculture Area to Industrial Area;
3. This Bylaw shall come into effect after third and final reading.



The purpose of the Public Hearing is to obtain public input on proposed **Bylaw 1323-18**. If you would like to make representations either in support of, or in opposition to, the proposed Bylaw, you will have the opportunity to make the representations to Council at this Public Hearing. If you are unable to attend the Hearing and would still like to make representations, you may also submit written comments by **12:00 p.m. (noon) on Friday, November 30, 2018**. Written submissions, received either by letter or email, will be read into the public record during the Hearing.
