



PUBLIC NOTICE

Take notice that the Council of Smoky Lake County is holding a Public Hearing with respect to a proposed bylaw pursuant to Sections 230, 606 & 692 of the *Municipal Government Act*.

The purpose of this Public Hearing is to obtain public input on proposed Bylaw No. 1322-18 which proposes to amend sections of Smoky Lake County Land Use Bylaw No. 127-14, to include provisions for production, distribution and sales of cannabis and cannabis-related accessories.
