- **Bylaw No. 1320-18: Council Code of Conduct Bylaw.**

Bylaw No. 1320-18: Public Notification - Purpose: The purpose of this Code of Conduct is to provide standards for the conduct of Council Members relating to their roles and obligations as elected representatives of the County and a procedure for the investigation and enforcement of those standards.

This Code of Conduct applies to all Members of Council and is one aspect of accountability and transparency both internally, as among Councillors and as between Council and Administration, as well as externally, with orders of government, the media, and the public at large.

This Code of Conduct provides a framework to guide ethical conduct in a way that upholds the integrity of the municipality and the high standards of professional conduct the public expects of its local government's elected representatives for Smoky Lake County. This Code of Conduct is intended to supplement existing legislation governing the conduct of Council Members.

It is important that you are well informed; and Council welcomes your valued input and comments about how Smoky Lake County will notify and address Public Involvement.
