WHY THE SHUTDOWN?

A Temporary Shutdown of the Capital Region Northeast Water Services Commission Regional Water Transmission Main Supply Line is scheduled for the above dates to accommodate a waterline replacement underneath the widening of Highway 15.



WHY DOES THIS CONCERN ME?

The Regional Water Transmission Main Supply Line is the primary water feed to the reservoir that supplies Highway 28/63 Regional Water Service Commission, which serves Smoky Lake County, the Town of Smoky Lake, Village of Waskatenau, and Village of Vilna.

WILL I HAVE WATER?

Municipal reservoirs will be filled prior to the shut down and all non-essential municipal water use (street sweeping, sewer flushing, hydrant flushing will be suspended.

Cistern barrel fills will remain open in Warspite, Bellis and Spedden.

All Bulk Water Truck Fill Stations will be shut down during above dates; and we ask that all Residents Restrict their Non-Essential Water Use.
