Land Use Bylaw Amendment - Telecommunications

Pursuant to Sections 230, 606, 631 and 692 of the *Municipal Government Act*, R.S.A. 2000, the Council of Smoky Lake County hereby gives notice of their intention to adopt:

Smoky Lake County Bylaw No. 1348-19

The purpose of this Bylaw is to Amend Smoky Lake County Land Use Bylaw 1272-14, for the purposes of Telecommunications.



The purpose of these changes is to establish and improve procedural standards that will allow Smoky Lake County to effectively participate in and influence the placement of telecommunication antenna structures proposed within the County limits.

These changes are also intended to assist Council, Administration, and Industry Canada, representatives of the telecommunication industry, and members of the public in being aware of and understanding the implementation methods, processes, procedures and criteria used to achieve this purpose.
