Application for 2019 Road Dust Control/Suppression

Smoky Lake County Public Works is accepting applications for blade mix oil or magnesium chloride dust control for rural roads within the County. The County will arrange for dust control/ suppression on roads in front of a residence with fees as follows:

Magnesium Chloride

\$850 for two (2) applications. The first application will take place in late spring. Upon inspection in September, a decision will be made on whether to proceed with the second application in the fall or wait until the following spring. Conditions of the treatment will determine the timing of the second application.

PAYMENT MUST BE RECEIVED WITH APPLICATIONS

Blade Mix Oil

\$3,000 for 2 1/2 inch thickness Length for the dust control/ suppression will be 150 meters (500 feet). Any additional length of dust treatment will be at the full cost to the applicant.
