2021 ROAD DUST CONTROL/SUPPRESSION APPLICATION

Smoky Lake County Public Works is accepting applications for blade mix oil or magnesium chloride dust control/ suppression for rural roads within the County in front of residences. Fees are as follows:

Magnesium Chloride

- \$850 for two (2) applications
- The first application will take place in late spring. Upon inspection in September, a decision will be made on whether to proceed with the second application in the fall or wait until the following spring. Conditions of the treatment will determine the timing of the second application.

Blade Mix Oil

- 3,000 for 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ inch thickness
- Length for the dust control/ suppression will be 150 meters (500 feet). Any additional length of dust treatment will be



NO DUMPING IN ROAD RIGHT OF WAY

Smoky Lake County requests your cooperation in keeping our County Road Right-of-Way clear of garbage and debris.

Field rocks, tires, furniture, car parts, wire, etc., causes damage to equipment, productivity downtime, and costly repairs.

Disposing of any litter or debris in the road right-of-way (the ditch) is an offense subject to penalties of up to \$500.00 under Bylaw 1241-12: Respecting Road Rights-of-Ways.
