Due to above average precipitation and fragile road conditions, effective **JUNE 25, 2020 at 11:00 AM** the following road restrictions are in place until further notice:

Gravel Roads

75% Axle Weight

Assigned Designated Routes according to Conditions; Prior to any type of hauling, Public Works <u>must</u> be contacted as several gravel roads may be banned from any type of hauling.

75 % Axle Weight

Limitations on the Number of Recreational Vehicles on Property

Section 7.23: Land Use Bylaw 1272-14 of Smoky Lake County

As camping season is upon us, please be reminded that Smoky Lake County has a bylaw which limits the number of Recreational Vehicles (RV's) on your property.

Multi-Lot County Residential (R1), Residential (Cluster) Conservation (R2), Victoria Residential (R3), and Hamlet Residential (R4) Districts:



- A maximum of two (2) RV's are allowed on a parcel without a development permit year-round.
- Additional RV's are permitted although, only for a maximum of four (4) consecutive days.
- If you wish to place three (3) RV's on your property on a year-round basis, a Development Permit is required by the Development Authority.
- This does not apply to parcels zoned as Agriculture (AG), Victoria Agriculture (A1), Highway Commercial (C1), Victoria Commercial (C2), Hamlet Commercial (C3), Industrial (M1), Rural Industrial (M2), Institutional & Community (P), Direct Control (DC), and Direct Control Landfill (DC1) Districts.

No recreational vehicle shall be permanently connected to any utility or municipal service, such as power, gas, water supply, or sanitary sewage disposal facilities unless the RV is located in an approved RV Park.

You may verify the zoning of your property by accessing the Public Web-map *http://munisightes.smokylake-county.ab.ca*, select "Login as guest" to enter the Web-map Site and turn on the "Zoning" and "Zoning Label" Layers under the Planning & Development tab.

NEWS RELEASE: DECLARATION OF MUNICIPAL AGRICULTURAL DISASTER

On June 25th, 2020 Smoky Lake County Council declared a Municipal Agricultural Disaster for Smoky Lake County. This declaration was made to call attention to the severe moisture conditions seen throughout the County. This declaration is to bring awareness to the unseeded acres due to excessive moisture and/or the inability to complete the 2019 harvest, the loss of seeded acres due to excessive moisture as well as pastureland and hay crops under water within Smoky Lake County. As stated in the RMA Guide for Declaring Municipal Agricultural Disasters, 'Municipal declarations do not automatically trigger access to increased funding programs, provincially or federally.' Bertha Armyworm traps are being monitored at various locations throughout the County since June, so far month populations have been low. While widespread infestations are unlikely, farmers should continue to inspect their crops for evidence of the pests. Bertha Armyworm monitoring will continue until early August. Alberta Insect Pest

Any person who desires to object to the entry of their name or that of any other person upon the said roll or to the assessed value placed upon any property must by July 31, 2020, lodge their complaint(s) in writing to the Chief Administrative Officer of Smoky Lake County.
