Notice is hereby given that the combined tax and assessment notices have been mailed as of June 14, 2023 to all property owners in Smoky Lake County. In accordance with Section 311 of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-26 R.S.A. 2000, all persons are deemed to have received their combined tax and assessment notices as a result of this notice.

The assessment roll is open for inspection at the County Office, 4612 McDougall Drive, Smoky Lake, Alberta during the business hours of 8:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. and 1:00p.m. - 4:00 p.m., Monday to Friday. Please call the County Office at 780-656-3730 to arrange for an appointment to inspect the assessment roll. Any person who desires to object to the entry of their name or that of any other person upon the said roll or to the assessed value placed upon any property must by August 21, 2023, lodge their complaint(s) in writing to the Chief Administrative Officer of Smoky Lake County.

Please review your Assessment and Tax Notice. If you have any questions, please contact the County Office.

A 12% penalty will be applied to any current taxes owing after October 31, 2023. If you do not receive your tax notice or have any other questions, please contact the County Office at 780-656-3730.

Fire permits will be issued on inspection only for essential burning.

Fireworks permits will be issued on a case by case basis.

The Fire Advisory allows burning barrels with safe burning practices in place and screens covering all barrels in use.

Off-Highway Vehicles can start wildfires – check frequently to ensure hot spots are free of debris, and ensure mufflers and spark arrestors are working properly.
