- Execute Contract Services Agreements with Shane Pospisil and Jane Dauphanie of Municipal Planning Services for the Regional Community Development Initiative.
- Met with Alberta Transportation and Municipal Planning Services regarding the subdivision and approach issues at Pepper's (including the Phillips property) and Spedden Inn. There seems to be no compromise from Alberta Transportation on the removal of the approaches at either location. Next step would be for the applicants to seek approval from the Minister.
- Met with several municipal representatives and our MP regarding the Cold Lake Oil Sands Area (CLOSA) Comprehensive Regional Infrastructure Sustainability Plan (CEISP) and the idea of a Canada Jobs Grant. Any input on either is welcome by the Regional Minister's Office.
- Met with Associated Engineering regarding the County Bridge Program. Gene and Doug are drafting a new Bridge Priority list based on the new funding realties from the provincial budget. We anticipate having the list brought to Council in September.
- County Office Building will finally be painted this coming weekend. It will be a nice shade of grey.
- I will be taking vacation from July 26 to August 6, 2013.
