

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

 - Within 10 m of boundaries of historic river lots (vegetation)



4 | Built Form & Land Use

- Subdivision regulations are consistent with LUB and MDP
- Agriculture is given highest priority
- Design requirements for residential development within the Heritage & Environment Area of lots that are visible from the Trail
- Restrictions on the clearing of vegetation
- Regulations that apply within the 6 viewscapes
- Resource extraction not allowed in locations that would risk the integrity of the Statements of Significance



4 | Built Form & Land Use

- Additional policy options
 - Agriculture Area
 - Support agriculture that cooperates with local interpretation programs or provides agri-tourism functions, incentives for barns/outbuildings of an architectural styling, right-to-farm policy, livestock keeping policy for country residential areas.
 - Country Residential
 - Right to farm caveats, small-scale farming opportunities.


