Warspite Truckfill - Water Costs

858-16: Lukinuk

That Smoky Lake County Council approve option (1), stated in an email from Gene Sobolewski, C.E.T. Project Manager, Associated Engineering Alberta Ltd., dated July 25, 2016, in regards to including plans for Warspite truckfill to provide water supplied by Highway 28/63 Regional Water Commission instead of potable water in the Request for Proposal for Tender being prepared by Associated Engineering Inc. as per motion 763-16 made at the June 16, 2016 Council Meeting for the completion of Spedden and Warspite truckfill stations as follows:

Option 1- Replace the Reservoir and obtain water from the Hwy 28/63 system. The system would be considered as non-potable, as no other process equipment is contemplated to be attached. More work (disinfection, monitoring, etc.) would be required to be a potable truckfill system. It would be connected to the existing truckfill piping for use in nonpotable applications. The existing priming pump would be replaced with lead/lag submersible pumps. I expect that some additional engineering costs would be incurred as Hwy 28/63 will likely want an analysis completed as to the expected demands and may have an issue with the "nonpotable" application. The electrical panels are intended to be moved and upgraded accordingly.
