

Present before Council was Erik Von Platen, District Fish and Wildlife Officer - Fish and Wildlife Enforcement Branch, Alberta Justice and Solicitor General, Public Security Division from 10:10 a.m. to 11:16 a.m. to discuss Legislation on Public Lands. Tori Ponich, Agricultural Fieldman, assembled the following information to accompany the discussion:





- The Crown owns the beds and shores of all permanent and naturally occurring bodies of water including wetlands in the White Area, and ALL the land in the Green Area, including its
- Differentiates wetlands into White (settled) and Green (forested) areas





Title to beds and shores, etc.

3(1) Subject to subsection (2) but notwithstanding any other law, the title to the beds and shores of

(a) all permanent and naturally occurring **bodies of water**, and (b) all naturally occurring rivers, streams, watercourses and lakes, is vested in the Crown in right of Alberta and a grant or certificate of title made or issued before, on or after May 31, 1984 does not convey title to those beds or shores.

(2) [...]

(3) For the purposes of subsection (1), a river, stream or watercourse does not cease to be naturally occurring by reason only that its water is diverted by human act.










17(2) When surveying a natural boundary that is a body of water, <u>the surveyor shall determine</u> the position of the line where the bed and shore of the body of water cease and the line is to be referred to as the <u>bank of the body of water</u>

17(3) For the purposes of this section, the bed and shore of a body of water shall be the land covered so long by water as to wrest it from vegetation or as to mark a distinct character on the vegetation where it extends into the water or on the soil itself











Municipal Government Act – Conservation Easements

Municipality accepts grants to keep the natural state of an area and allows for negotiable land uses and public access

Conservation Easements

 Ownership remains with the landowner who may get tax benefits or lowered taxes due to the reduction in assessment value related to the reduced potential for development
