**Finance Department:**

Brenda Adamson, Finance Manager provided a demonstration of searching a property on the public version of MuniSight which uses Altalis, Land Titles, Accurate Assessment and Bellamy data. Tax Rolls should untimely match AltaLIS data.

- Information provided by AltaLIS, which is owned by the province and used for Alberta Land Titles.
- Carleigh McMullin, Tax Clerk manually enters data from Land Titles twice a month and, also manually enters phone numbers when provided from rate payers into the Bellamy System, which is downloaded and automatically populates the data the next day into MuniSight.

**Public Works:**

Doug Ponich, Public Works Manager spoke to the Transportation layer on MuniSight. Culverts are mapped in the Transportation layer.

- In 2007 MuniSight physically drove our roads and noted all visible culvert and sign locations.
- Public Works routinely provides updates on the culvert specifications, locations and installations as well as any new or missing information. The Tremble GIS device is used by crews where there is poor cell service and cell phones with the App may be used as well to identify and collect data in the future.
- Bus routes can be entered when/if provided by Aspen View.

**AVL (Automatic Vehicle Location) - Update**

Dave Kully, Public Works Shop Foreman and Paul Miranda, Communications/GIS Director spoke to AVL (Automatic Vehicle Location) which is defined as a means for automatically determining and transmitting the geographic location of a vehicle.

This vehicle location data is collectable from approximately 40 Units including all graders, the dozer, all gravel trucks, two tandem sand

trucks and the single axle sand truck, the service truck, the Public Works Manager's and Road Foremen's truck, the Peace Officer's truck, all fire units, tractors used for snowplowing, and weed spraying units.

The AVL also can track the gravel trucks from the pit to the point where they dump their load of gravel.

**County Drone - Update**

Paul Miranda, Communications/GIS Director and Scott Franchuk, Fire Chief spoke to Council about the County Drone, which can be used for weed detection and identifying fire hot spots among other things. The drone camera can zoom from 1.5 miles away and take a picture as if you were standing 20 feet away.

Scott and Paul have taken the drone advanced exam which requires a minimum amount of flying time. Other employees can complete a more common basic exam.
