Purpose: To monitor the discharge of Fireworks.

Policy Statement and Guidelines: 1. **STATEMENT:** 1.1 Fireworks are a safety issue that can result in harm to individuals and property. 1.2 Smoky Lake County, will allow fireworks in respect to "Bylaw No. 1363-19" to regulate and control the setting off of fireworks within the geographical area of the County by a permit issued by the County Fire Chief or delegate (Deputy Fire Chief or Peace Officer). 2. DEFINITIONS 2.1County Fire Chief: means the individual who is appointed Fire Chief of the County, or his or her delegate (Deputy Fire Chief or Peace Officer). 2.2 Consumer Fireworks: are low-hazard and designed for recreational use. They include items like Roman candles, sparklers, fountains, volcanoes, mines, and snakes. Classified as F.1. 2.3 Display Fireworks: are high-hazard and designed for professional use. They include items like areal shells, cakes, Roman candles, waterfalls, lances and wheels. Classified ad F.2.
