FIRE BAN & OFF-HIGHWAY VEHICLE RESTRICTION

Effective: July 17, 2024

A fire ban and off-highway vehicle (OHV) restriction is in effect for Smoky Lake County. This will stay in effect until fire hazard conditions improve significantly.

- No outdoor fires are allowed. Including, but not limited to: open fires, campfires, brush piles or burning barrels
- Use of fireworks is prohibited.
- No person shall operate an off-highway vehicle on municipal property, highway, permitted use area, or trail in Smoky Lake County as per Bylaw No. 1454-24.
